



Frequently Asked Questions

What play are you performing? Julius Caesar by, of course, the bard.

When are the performances? (Friday and Saturday) August 9, 10, and (Thursday, Friday, and Saturday) 15, 16, & 17. All performances start at 7:30. **American Sign Language interpretation on Saturdays.**

Where are the performances? Outdoors at Historic St Mary's City on the lawn of the State House.

How long is the show? The show runs about 2 hours, including intermission.

Is the show appropriate for children? Even though Julius Caesar is considered a "tragedy," we still consider this is a family friendly event. FYI, *Trigger Warning* – This production includes Roman assassination and suicide.

How do I get tickets? To find the link to purchase tickets online, you may go to either the HSMC website www.HSMCdigsHistory.org or the Newtowne Player's website www.newtowneplayers.org. You can also purchase tickets in Farthing's Gift Shop (box office) the evening of the performance. The Box Office will open at 6:30.

How much are tickets? The Friday and Saturday performances have the following ticket prices: \$15 for adults; \$13 for NTP Members and Friends of HSMC; \$12 for seniors, military, and students; \$10 for children 6 – 11; children 5 and younger are free. ***There is special discount price of \$10 for the Thursday performance no matter your demographic or affiliation.***

Where do I pick up my tickets? Inside The Shop at Farthing's Ordinary.

When should I arrive? The *Will Call Desk* and *Box Office* open 1 hour before the start of the show, but you are welcome to arrive as early as 6 to claim lawn space.

Where do I park? The State House parking lot off of Route 5.

What should I bring? Food, blankets, and lawn chairs are welcome on site. Bug repellent is also recommended. Please do **not** bring your pets as they are not allowed on site.

Can I purchase food and/or alcoholic beverages on site? There will be food and beverage service available provided by **Enso Kitchen**, the bakery operating out of Farthing's Kitchen. They will have a short, but excellent offering of sandwiches and snacks. Due to liquor license issues, **only alcoholic beverages purchased on site will be allowed.** Be prepared to use cash or check only for alcoholic beverages please.

What if it rains? The show must and will go on! We will have a large tent set up in case of rain. We will only cancel the show if circumstances become hazardous for our audience and performers.

I've purchased tickets and now am unable to attend that night, can I get a refund? Tickets are non-refundable, but we are happy to change your reservations to another evening.

What if I forget to bring a blanket or chair? We will have chairs available to rent for \$1. There will also be bug repellent wipes available for purchase for \$1 as well.
