



Summer Camp Behavior Contract

As a parent/guardian of the above-named child, I understand and agree to the following behavior guidelines and expectations for participation in the summer camp program:

1. Respect for Others:

- My child will treat fellow campers, camp staff, and volunteers with respect, kindness, and consideration at all times.
- My child will refrain from any form of bullying, harassment, or discrimination based on race, gender, religion, nationality, disability, or any other factor.
- My child will follow the instructions of camp staff and volunteers promptly and respectfully.

2. Respect for Property:

- My child will respect camp property, facilities, equipment, and the personal belongings of others.
- My child will not engage in any vandalism, theft, or destruction of property.
- I understand that I am financially responsible for any damage caused by my child to camp property or equipment.

3. Safety Guidelines:

- My child will follow all safety guidelines and rules set forth by the camp.
- I will inform camp staff of any relevant medical or behavioral concerns regarding my child.
- My child will not bring any prohibited items to camp, including weapons, drugs, alcohol, or tobacco products.

4. Attendance and Punctuality:

- My child will attend camp regularly and arrive on time each day.
- I will notify camp staff in advance if my child will be absent or late for any reason.

5. Communication:

- I will maintain open and respectful communication with camp staff regarding any concerns or issues related to my child's participation in the program.



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- I understand that camp staff may contact me in case of an emergency or concerning behavior.

6. Cooperation with Camp Policies:

- My child will adhere to all camp policies and procedures, including those related to meals, snacks, hygiene, and appropriate behavior.
- I will review camp policies with my child and ensure their understanding and compliance.

7. Consequences of Misbehavior:

- Verbal Warning:
 - First verbal warning: A verbal warning will be issued, reminding the camper of the rules or expectations.
 - Second verbal warning: Another verbal warning will be given, emphasizing the seriousness of the issue and the need for improvement.
 - Third verbal warning: Final verbal warning will be issued, clearly stating the consequences if behavior does not improve.
- Written Warning (Behavior Report):
 - Following the third verbal warning, an official written warning will be sent via a physical behavior report to the camper's parent/guardian, detailing the behavior that needs to be addressed and the consequences if it continues.
- Loss of Privileges:
 - If the behavior persists after verbal and written warnings, the camper may temporarily lose certain privileges, such as the use of props, helping with costumes, etc, as a consequence for their actions.
- Dismissal from the Program:
 - Continued disregard for the rules and failure to improve despite warnings may result in dismissal from the program. This decision will be made by the Camp Producer and Camp Director after careful consideration of the situation.
- I understand that failure to adhere to the behavior guidelines outlined in this contract may result in disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal from the camp program.
- I will support camp staff in enforcing consequences for my child's misbehavior.



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8. Agreement:
